

## **Shoshone/Clark's Fork CRM Information Sheet**

The CRM has been formed to address removal of Russian olive and Salt Cedar trees in the respective drainage. It has become obvious that the consequences of allowing these noxious plants to infest the land are not an option for those who care for their land. The CRM has applied for and received funds in the form of a grant from the State of Wyoming to subsidize private landowner efforts to remove these trees from their land.

Priority will go from upstream to downstream. This does not mean that downstream owners cannot receive help if they are ready to proceed and funds remain available.

To qualify the landowner should be prepared to participate in the cost and effort required to complete the two-year program which requires mechanical removal, followed by a two-year period of chemical control of regrowth. Failure of the landowner to complete the full two-part program will obligate him to return all his funding to the CRM.

In general, the CRM will fund 85% of detailed invoices presented by the landowner with a maximum cap on costs/acre of mechanical removal and chemical control of regrowth. Payments to the landowner will be made after mechanical treatment and again after the two-year maintenance period.

CRM volunteer members in conjunction with the landowner will be called upon to survey and measure the acreage both before and after the mechanical treatment and again after the two-year period. Measurement will be done with a GPS device. Before and after photographs will also be required. Landowners will most likely be asked to volunteer to administer the same support to other landowners.

Park County Weed and Pest will offer support as to methods and chemicals that have been found to be effective. Also, they will discount chemical required by 50%. Landowner will acquire and compensate the contractors of their choice. All funding from the CRM is reportable to the IRS.
