

COMMON MULLEIN

(*Verbascum thapsus* L.)

GROWTH HABIT: Biennial; produces a large, thick rosette of fuzzy leaves the first year and a single, stout, erect stem, 2 to 6 feet tall, the second year.

LEAVES: Alternate, overlapping one another, light green, densely woolly.

FLOWERS: Sessile, borne in long terminal spikes, sulfur yellow, five-lobed and more than an inch in diameter.

FRUITS: Two-chambered with numerous, small, angular, brownish seeds, 1/32 inch long.
