

FLIXWEED

(Descurania sophia)

GROWTH HABIT: Flixweed is a winter annual; 8 to 24 inches high.

LEAVES: Leaves alternate, two to three times pinnately compound; segments very narrow or linear; with branched hairs or nearly smooth.

FLOWER: Inflorescence a raceme; petals very small, yellow or greenish-yellow, pod partitioned with two or three longitudinal nerves, siliques $\frac{1}{2}$ to $1\frac{1}{4}$ inch long.

OTHER: This mustard is distinguished from other mustards because of its finely dissected leaves. Flixweed spreads by seeds from early to late summer.
