

OXEYE DAISY

(Chrysanthemum leucanthemum)

GROWTH HABIT: Perennial, erect to 2 feet tall.

LEAVES: Lower leaves lance-shaped, 2 to 5 inches long including short stalk, margins lobed or deeply parted; upper leaves lance-shaped, attached directly to stem, margins toothed.

STEMS: Numerous from root crown, terminating in flowers.

FLOWER: Solitary, 1½ inches wide, numerous white petals and a yellow center.

ROOTS: Fibrous.

SEEDS: Straw colored, 1/8 inch long.

OTHER: Eurasian introduction, escaped from cultivation.
