Grass Seed Mixes Now Available From PCWP!

As a Weed and Pest District one of the many practices we encourage landowners is to manage their lands for desirable species including maintaining healthy stands of grass species. Weeds have a more difficult time becoming established if they have no place to spread their wings er roots! This also allows a landowner to control any noxious (or nuisance) weed species with herbicides should the need arise. Recognizing this important component of an integrated management strategy, we now carry several locally sourced seed mixes that are suitable for most areas of the county. The seed comes in 24# bags and should cover approximately 2 acres. The following mixes are currently available:
